Stay warm

All pets need extra care in particularly cold weather, but older pets and those with thin coats are especially vulnerable.

Signs your pet is too cold:

- Shaking or shivering
- Reluctance to walk
- Hunched posture
- Lifting paws off the ground

Keep them warm:

- Jackets, sweaters, and booties
- Bring outdoor pets inside
- Shorten walks for vulnerable pets
- Don't leave pets in cars

Wipe paws before coming inside to remove salt and chemicals
